**Joseph Remy** is a Staff Attorney and Program Manager at the National White Collar Crime Center (NW3C), where he develops and delivers curriculum for prosecutors and law enforcement on a wide range of digital technology and cybercrime issues.

A former prosecutor, Remy has investigated and prosecuted complex cases involving cybercrime, financial and insurance fraud, and child exploitation. He has also drafted legislative proposals addressing emerging criminal justice issues. His prosecutorial experience includes serving as a Deputy Attorney General with the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General; Section Head of the Financial, Insurance, and Cyber Crime Units in the Burlington County Prosecutor’s Office; Assistant Prosecutor in the Atlantic County Prosecutor’s Office Special Victims Unit; and Assistant District Attorney in the New York County (Manhattan) District Attorney’s Office. Earlier in his career, Remy practiced criminal defense with the Law Office of Edward T. McCormack, Esq.

Remy has completed professional training through INTERPOL, the FBI, NW3C, NCFI, and numerous other federal, state, and nonprofit organizations.

He is an active member of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences, the Scientific Working Group on Digital Evidence (SWGDE), and the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) Computer Crime and Digital Evidence Committee, and serves on the NW3C Prosecutors and Judges Committee. Remy also serves on the Board of the New Jersey Coalition Against Human Trafficking, where he co-chairs the Legislative Committee.

Remy is admitted to practice before the International Criminal Court, the Supreme Court of the United States, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, the U.S. District Courts for the District of New Jersey and the Southern District of New York, and the state bars of New Jersey and New York.

A frequent speaker at international, national, and state conferences, Joseph Remy is also a Certified Blockchain Expert, a Certified Cyber Crime Examiner, and a practicing Emergency Medical Technician.
