Financial Crime	<p>This course presents awareness-level information on a variety of topics related to white collar crime. The course covers basic definitions and terminology, common types of white collar crime, and the effects of white collar crime on society. Students learn to recognize and respond to common internet scams, provide assistance to victims of white collar crime, and recognize warning signs and red flags of criminal behavior. This course emphasizes law enforcement’s role in preventing and responding to white collar crime, and includes additional resources for combating this widespread problem.</p> <p>The basics.
