## Who We Are

For more than three decades, NW3C has worked to support law enforcement's efforts to prevent, investigate and prosecute economic and high-tech crime. NW3C strengthens this mission by staying current with technological innovations and working to keep law enforcement up-to-date. NW3C is a nonprofit, membership-affiliated organization comprised of state, local, federal and tribal law enforcement and prosecutorial and regulatory agencies. Its work is funded primarily by grants through congressional appropriations from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) and other federal agencies.



### Training and Technical Assistance

Annually, NW3C delivers training to thousands of law enforcement professionals in the areas of computer forensics, cybercrime, financial crime and intelligence analysis. In the last five years, NW3C has trained nearly 70,000 students and provided hundreds of hours of technical assistance to law enforcement.



### Online Learning

NW3C offers online courses for law enforcement on topics ranging from cyber investigations to legal concerns for digital evidence responders. To date, NW3C has provided nearly 20,000 online training sessions to law enforcement.



### Forensic Tools

NW3C distributes valuable forensic tools to law enforcement free of charge. Our TUX4N6™ software allows investigators to preview a hard drive without writing to or altering data on it. PerpHound™ enables law enforcement to analyze call detail records from cell phone companies.
